

MICROBIOLOGY, DOCTORAL MINOR

REQUIREMENTS

The minor in microbiology requires 10 credits of courses at the 300 level or above offered by the departments of Medical Microbiology and Immunology (M M & I courses (http://guide.wisc.edu/courses/m_m_i/)) or Bacteriology (MICROBIO courses (<http://guide.wisc.edu/courses/microbio/>)). At least half of the credits must come from the Microbiology Doctoral Training Program (MDTP) course list (<http://guide.wisc.edu/graduate/bacteriology/microbiology-phd/#requirements>). At least one member of the student's thesis committee must be faculty in either the bacteriology or medical microbiology and immunology departments, and will serve as the student's minor advisor.
