REQUIREMENTS

REQUIREMENTS

Students must complete 10 credits of courses numbered 300 or above offered by the departments of Medical Microbiology and Immunology (M & I courses (http://guide.wisc.edu/courses/m_m_i/)) or Microbiology (MICROBIO courses (<http://guide.wisc.edu/courses/microbio/>)).

At least half of the credits must be from the Microbiology Doctoral Training Program (MDTP) course list (<http://guide.wisc.edu/graduate/bacteriology/microbiology-phd/#requirements>). At least one member of the student's thesis committee must be faculty in either the bacteriology or medical microbiology and immunology departments, and will serve as the student's minor advisor.
