DOCTORAL MINORS

Breadth is a required component of doctoral training at UW–Madison. A student's doctoral major program determines how breadth is achieved: students either complete an additional program of a doctoral minor or graduate/professional certificate (p.), or breadth is built into the doctoral major program curriculum. Most major programs advise students to enroll in a doctoral minor or graduate/professional certificate to meet the breadth requirement. If a doctoral minor or graduate/professional/capstone certificate is not required by the student's doctoral major program, it is noted on the Requirements tab of the *Guide* degree or named option page.
