#### Mode of Instruction Definitions

**Accelerated:** Accelerated programs are offered at a fast pace that condenses the time to completion. Students typically take enough credits aimed at completing the program in a year or two.

**Evening/Weekend:** Courses meet on the UW-Madison campus only in evenings and/or on weekends to accommodate typical business schedules. Students have the advantages of face-to-face courses with the flexibility to keep work and other life commitments.

**Face-to-Face:** Courses typically meet during weekdays on the UW-Madison Campus.

**Hybrid:** These programs combine face-to-face and online learning formats. Contact the program for more specific information.

**Online:** These programs are offered 100% online. Some programs may require an on-campus orientation or residency experience, but the courses will be facilitated in an online format.

### REQUIRED COURSES

Students are required to take two semesters of statistics/methods (PSYCH 610 (<http://guide.wisc.edu/about://search/?P=PSYCH%20610>) and PSYCH 710 (<http://guide.wisc.edu/about://search/?P=PSYCH%20710>)). Two of the six additional courses should be outside the student's area of research expertise. Students must also complete a required First-Year Project. Students must register and attend a Proseminar meeting each academic year semester (fall/spring) during their first three years. Students are encouraged to continue to register and attend a proseminar in later years while in residence. Students must reach 30 credits to earn the masters.
