

SPANISH-ENGLISH BILINGUAL- BICULTURAL EDUCATION, CAPSTONE CERTIFICATE

The Capstone Certificate in Spanish-English Bilingual-Bicultural Education will offer coursework focused on teaching, learning, and curriculum that supports the development of bilingualism, biculturalism, and biliteracy. Coursework in Curriculum and Instruction will focus K-12 pupils who speak Spanish as a home language and participate in bilingual programs (or "English Learners") in Wisconsin public schools. Please note that coursework will be offered in Spanish.

Program completion will result in a capstone certificate. Educators interested in obtaining a Spanish-English bilingual-bicultural certification from the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction will need to apply through the School of Education Student Services (<https://education.wisc.edu/about/student-services/>) office.

Admission into the capstone certificate program will require (1) current WI teaching license, (2) demonstration of "advanced-low" Spanish language proficiency on the ACTFL oral and written exams.
