### HOW TO GET IN

Students must have a 2.000 GPA on coursework counting in the major, and a 2.000 GPA on any upper-level work in the major completed prior to declaration. No specific coursework must be completed to declare. For students below a 2.000 GPA, please contact [iSciadvicing@ischool.wisc.edu](mailto:iSciadvicing@ischool.wisc.edu) to discuss options and a path to declaring the Information Science major.

It is recommended that students declare the major as early as possible to plan for required coursework. First semester students without a calculated GPA are eligible to declare.
